





Before joining sports training run by Oasis India in Kalwa, Mumbai, Anuradha was a shy, quiet, and reserved girl. When her family moved to the area in search of better opportunities, her mother discovered the Kalwa Centre and enrolled Anuradha and her siblings into a child development programme.

Although Anuradha wasn't used to sports and struggled with discomfort at first, over time her strength and endurance improved, aided by gentle guidance from her trainers and constant encouragement from her peers. Her growing enthusiasm turned into a passion for Kabaddi and other team sports. Through this journey, she discovered not only the thrill of sports but also the values of teamwork, discipline, and perseverance.

"At first, it was difficult to do workouts, but now I run fast and remember all the steps. I feel very happy being part of sports. Back in my village, there were no such opportunities. Here, we learn not only how to play but also how to stay disciplined and work together," she says proudly.
