Music Group Rehearsals





HARNESSING THE SUN



"The first thing I did in the morning at the hospital was to listen for the sound of the generator. It was the first thing to tell me if a child had made it through the night" – BMS World Mission doctor, Tom Spears

At the crossroads of north and central Africa, Chad is a tough country to live in. Life expectancy is 52.5 years and, on average, children only receive 2.5 years of education. N'Djamena, the capital of Chad, suffers from regular power shortages and it's not uncommon for people to experience five to six hour power cuts. In a country that, on average, has 264 days of sunlight a year, attention has moved to solar power.

Guinebor II Hospital (G2) has always relied on diesel fuel and an array of solar panels to power the wards – however, this system had issues. The solar system had a small charge and couldn't be fixed by anyone in Chad. When someone required oxygen, a diesel generator would have to be brought round to power the concentrators. Medication was going out of date due

to overheating storage fridges, babies were delivered by torchlight and the wards had no fans

But, excitingly, a recent project has enabled G2's solar capacity to increase threefold, massively reducing its dependence on diesel. The project was also completed alongside a Chadian electrician, equipping the community with the skills to repair and maintain the solar array. With all these improvements, new wards being built now have fans pre-installed. There's no need for generators in the wards anymore. And amazingly, the pharmacy now has air conditioning!
